RULES OF PLAY FOR THE ADULT SPORT ACTIVITIES

In order to ensure the safety of the School, its students, and players, the following rules will be duly observed and obeyed at all times.

1. PERMISSION TO PLAY: Sport activity may be played in the school facility when there is no conflict with other school activities. The School Principal and Vice Principal reserve the right to suspend play for official school business meetings or violation of these rules.

2. PLAY TIME: Sport activities may not begin before 9:15 am and must end before 10:50 am on school days when the gym is not being used for other school business. All players must leave the gym by 11:10 am before the dance classes start. Dance classes, cultural activities, and other school activities have priority in the usage of the school facility, such as the gym and cafetorium. At the end of the day, players must vacate the gym by 12:30pm.

3. NO FOOD OR DRINK: ABSOLUTELY NO FOOD OR DRINK is allowed in the gym at any time. All eating or drinking must take place in the cafeteria.

4. ELIGIBLE PLAYERS: Only registered (full or associate) members of the Monmouth Chinese School may play in the school. The team captain shall maintain a list of registered players and provide a copy of the list to the School Principal. Non-members of the School may not play in the school without a written permission of the Principal.

5. FOOTWEAR: For the safety of the players, only players with appropriate footwear are allowed to play.

6. LIABILITY: The School assumes no risk or liability for permitting the play of sport activities in school. All individuals play at their own risk and cost for personal injury. The player, by his Signature below, acknowledges this risk and agreement.

7. **VIOLATION:** Failure to observe or obey these rules will lead to immediate suspension of play. The player is responsible for damage to school property and personal injury inflicted by the player. Individual player may lose the privilege to play. The team captain is responsible for enforcing these rules.

8. SIGNATURE: By his/her signature, the player acknowledges that he/she has read this set of rules and agrees to abide by them. If player is under 18, parent must sign to acknowledge the minor's participation.
